- **Works With Texts:** You can also slice texts with this tool, but it has its own quirks. For best results, convert the text to a shape by welding or attaching it to a shape layer before slicing.

Knowing these things will help you use the Slice tool in the Cricut app, which enables you to make precise designs.

How to Slice on Cricut Design Space?

Here are the 4 simple steps to use the Slice tool in the Cricut software:

Step 1: Arrange the Images

The first thing you have to do is select and then drag the images so they overlap. In case the images are not overlapping and you try to slice, nothing will happen.

Step 2: Select the Layers

Slicing an image works only with two layers at a time. Therefore, you must keep two layers when using the tool. When you select both layers, a gray bounding box appears around the images. Now, you can see each layer shown in the **Layers** panel.

Step 3: Click the Slice Button



After that, tap on the **Slice** button on your phone or computer. On a computer, you can find it at the bottom of the Layers panel, while on a mobile phone, you can check it in the **Action menu**.

Step 4: Check the Result

Now, separate all the layers to see the newly formed shapes. These shapes can be edited individually. You can also delete any layer if you do not want to use it in your project.
