

Types of Commercial Trucks and Their Uses

While that's true, the top **flatbed trucking companies** offer much more.

Beyond conventional flatbed transporting services, the most reputable companies rely on many different commercial trucks. As a result, they have the ability to provide a much broader range of services to their valued customers.

The next time you need something transported from point A to point B, start by researching the most reliable flatbed trucking companies in your area. There's an excellent chance you'll discover they have all types of commercial trucks, including those listed below

•**Refrigerated** – As the name implies, transportation companies use refrigerated trucks as a means of transporting perishable food, including frozen goods and produce. In some instances, pharmaceutical companies also have a need for this type of commercial truck.

•Lowboys – As part of their overall services, the top-rated flatbed trucking companies have a fleet of high-quality lowboy trailers. Because these commercial trucks can haul between 40,000 and 80,000 pounds based on the number of axles, they're ideal for heavy loads taller than the legal height allowed with other trailers.

•Step-deck – It's normal for top flatbed trucking companies to have step-deck trailers since they're very similar to a standard flatbed. The only difference is that from a legal perspective, this commercial truck has a 10-foot maximum freight height. For that reason, these trucks can haul things a conventional flatbed can't due to height restrictions.

•Extendable Flatbed – Along with standard flatbed transporting services, most companies have extendable trailers, which means they can stretch in length from about 43 to 80-feet.

•Stretch, Single-drop Deck – For extra-long loads that a standard drop deck trailer can't accommodate, companies use this commercial truck. The stretch, single-drop deck trailer has a maximum length of 35 to 63 feet and a maximum weight limit of 45,000 pounds.

•**Removable Gooseneck** – For both heavy and tall loads, the top flatbed trucking companies turn to this option. With a maximum 150,000-pound capacity and up to a 20-axle option, these trailers are beasts.

•Sidekit – For unpacked loads, including dirt, gravel, rock, and so on, trucking companies often use these wood-sided panelled trucks.

•Additional Options – For the best transportation companies to offer a full scope of flatbed transporting services, they maintain a fleet of even more trucks. For example, they use specialty trailers for hauling liquids and hazardous materials, extendable double-drop trailers for extra-long cargo, and stretch removable gooseneck trailers with a payload between 42,000 and 150,000 pounds, among others.
